1. Delete: On page 163, the entry for HIST 346, Medieval Europe:	
346	Medieval Europe (3) An analysis of civilization in Western Europe from the fall of the Roman Empire in the West to the High Middle Ages, with special emphasis given to social history and church-state relations. See department chair.
2. Add: On page 163, new course, HIST 347, History of Ireland	
347	History of Ireland (3)

A survey of Irish history from the pre-Celts to the late twentieth century. Special emphasis on politics and religious nationalism within the context of union with and independence from Britain. See department chair.

Impact Statement:

There will be no impact on the resources and staffing of the History department due to this change.

Rationale:

The subject matter of History 346 (Medieval Europe) is covered at the introductory level in Humanities 214. This 300-level course has been taught for the past two decades by a faculty member who is not a medievalist by training. The addition of a survey in Irish history, together with the expansion of History 348 to survey ancient and medieval Britain will allow for a more focused treatment of medieval subject matter in fields where the instructor has expertise.
