The social, political and religious history of England from 1485 to 1688: Henry VIII and the Reformation, Puritanism and the rise of the gentry, the Civil War and the victory of parliamentary government. See department chair.

Add: On page 163, in place of deleted entry:

### 348 Britain to 1688 (3)

The social, political and religious history of Britain from the pre-Roman period to 1688: Roman contributions, Anglo-Saxon institutions, struggle between church and state, evolution of parliament and the rule of law, Henry VIII and the Reformation, Puritanism and Civil War, and the emergence of limited monarchy. See department chair.

### **Impact Statement:**

There will be no impact on the resources and staffing of the History department due to this change.

### **Rationale:**

This change will allow for a traditional two-semester survey of British history. Paired with History 350, Britain Since 1688, the sequence will be in line with current practice in the field of British history. Material now covered in History 348 will still be included, but instead of beginning the course in 1485, it will now begin with pre-Roman developments.
