1. Delete: On page 191, the entries for Minor in Literature and Minor in Creative Writing:

Minor in Literature

18 hours in Literature: Lit 241 (with no more than three additional hours selected from 200-level courses), six hours selected from LIT 321, 322, 323, 324; six to nine additional hours selected from courses above 300 level. Students must earn a minimum 2.00 grade-point-average on all minor courses taken at UNC Asheville. One-half of the hours required for a minor must be completed at UNC Asheville, to include at least 6 semester hours of 300-400 level courses

Minor in Creative writing

18 hours in Literature and Language courses; LIT 241, 6 hours selected from LIT 321, 322, 323, 324; 9 additional hours selected from LANG 361, 363, 365, 366, 367, 368, 461, 463, 465, or 466. At least 3 of these hours must be at the 400-level. Students wanting to minor in Creative Writing should follow the application procedures listed under Declaration of Major in Literature and Language. Students must earn a minimum 2.00 grade-point-average on all minor courses taken at UNC Asheville. One-half of the hours required for a minor must be completed at UNC Asheville, to include at least 6 semester hours of 300-400 level courses.

Add: On page 191, in place of deleted entries:

Minor in Literature

18 hours in Literature: LIT 240; 8 hours selected from LIT 324, 334 or 335; 6 additional hours of LIT at the 300-400 level. LIT 340 cannot be used as part of the 6 additional hours. Students must earn a minimum 2.00 grade-point-average on all minor courses taken at UNC Asheville. One-half of the hours required for a minor must be completed at UNC Asheville, to include at least 6 semester hours of 300-400 level courses.

Minor in Creative writing

18 hours in Literature and Language: LANG 260 and LIT 240; 4 hours selected from LIT 325, 326 or 327; 6 additional hours selected from LANG 361, 363, 365, 366, 367, 368, 461, 463, 465 or 466. Students wanting to minor in Creative Writing should follow the

same application procedures required for majors in Creative Writing, listed under Declaration of Major in Literature and Language. Students must earn a minimum 2.00 grade-point-average on all minor courses taken at UNC Asheville. One-half of the hours required for a minor must be completed at UNC Asheville, to include at least 6 semester hours of 300-400 level courses.

Impact:

There should be no impact on the staffing and resources of the Literature and Language Dept.

Rationale:

These changes reflect revisions to the general literature curriculum and still keep minor hours at 18.
