## 338 Photographic Lab Management (1)

Students build on skills learned in previous classes, working with the instructor to learn the finer points of maintaining a darkroom. Through practical, hands-on lab experience, students will gain a greater knowledge of both chemical and mechanical aspects of darkroom practice. May be repeated as content varies for a total of 3 hours credit. Prerequisite: ART 227 and permission of instructor.

## Impact:

There will be no impact in terms of staffing, facilities or equipment purchase.

## Rationale:

This course will provide students with the opportunity to learn additional skills in darkroom management, how to mix chemicals safely for the development of black and white photography and how to troubleshoot problems in the darkroom. Previously, this was listed as a special topics course. However, with the increase in the number of photography majors, it seems reasonable to offer this as a regular course.
