Add: On page 68, in place of deleted entry:

I. Required courses in the major—47 hours, including: ART 110, 111, 112, either 113 or 114, 400, 401; one course from 210, 220 or 227;

Impact Statement:

Effective Date: Fall 2012

This change is not expected to impact the facilities, staff, or equipment necessary to deliver the curriculum. Students will now be able to choose photography as an option for fulfilling overall major requirements.

Rationale:

Prior to this change, ART 227 could only be used as part of the 9 studio hours in one media for the students choosing photography as their concentration. Adding the course as an option with ART 210 or 220 will allow these students to use more advanced courses to fulfill the studio requirements, thus making them more prepared for the capstone courses and their senior exhibitions. This change places the photography curriculum in line with the other concentrations in the department and will enhance a sense of continuity across the department.
