Statement of Faculty Senate Action:

APC Document 55:

Change descriptions for DRAM 105 and 106

Effective Date: Fall 2012

1. Delete: On page 115, the description for **DRAM 105, Theatre Practicum:**

Intensive laboratory experience in one area of theatre production. Subject arranged individually. May be repeated for a total of 8 hours credit. Does not count toward Drama major. Permission of instructor is required. Grading S/U. Fall and Spring.

Add: On page 115, in place of deleted entry:

Intensive laboratory experience in one area of theatre production. Subject arranged individually. May be repeated for a total of 4 hours of credit. Permission of instructor is required. Grading S/U. Fall and Spring.

2. Delete: On page 115, the description for **DRAM 106, Theatre Production:**

Intensive laboratory experience in production and performance work for Theatre UNCA. Drama majors are required to complete 6 hours of production for graduation. Drama minors are required to complete 2 hours of production for graduation. Open only to Drama majors or minors. May be repeated for a total of 6 hours. Permission of instructor is required. Fall and Spring.

Add: On page 115, in place of deleted entry:

Intensive laboratory experience in production and performance work for Theatre UNCA. Open only to Drama majors or minors. May be repeated for a total of 6 hours of credit. Permission of instructor is required. Fall and Spring.

Impact:

There is no impact to staffing or sustainability within the department because Dram 105 and 106 are already being taught.

Rationale:

Changing the descriptions of Dram 105 and 106 allows for continued growth and reorganization of production credits for students while creating flexibility in the Drama curriculum. This creates a system for counting the student and faculty time devoted to our laboratory component: realized productions.
