## 346 Theatre History Investigations (3)

Close examination of selected eras, artists, plays, or ideas in theatre history. Topics are covered on a rotational basis. May be repeated as topics vary for a total of 9 hours of credit. Prerequisite: DRAM 240. See department chair.

## Impact:

This will allow students with an interest in theatre history and literature an outlet for further study. There will be no additional faculty or resources needed because this course was previously offered as 358.

## Rationale:

By teaming this course with DRAM 240, Survey of Theatre History, a required course that provides a broad overview, it allows students who are interested in theatre history, literature, or theory a greater opportunity to go deeper into a variety of subjects. Without this change, such courses were offered infrequently due to the demands of the rotation.
