Delete ACCT 330 and ACCT 412

Effective Date: Fall 2012

1.Delete: On page 200, the entry for **ACCT 330**:

330 Accounting Applications (3)

A software-based course that introduces students to various applications used by accountants. A tutorial approach will be used and students will obtain significant hands-on experience in different types of accountingbased software. Pre- or corequisite: ACCT 301. See department chair.

2. Delete: On page 200, the entry for ACCT 412:

412 Advanced Managerial Accounting (3)

A detailed treatment of the planning and control techniques used to generate information for managerial decision-making. Cost and profit analysis for manufacturing and non-manufacturing concerns. Prerequisite: ACCT 317. Pre- or corequisite: MGMT 380. No credit given to students who have credit for ACCT 318. Odd years Spring.

Impact:

The impact to the Department and to the students should be minimal. These changes do not change the number of hours required for the accounting major.

Rationale:

Much of the material originally covered in ACCT 330 is being integrated into other required courses. ACCT 412 was required for the Managerial Concentration, which is being removed.
