Impact:

The impact on the resources of the Department will be minimal because this course will be offered on a rotating basis. Rotation of courses allows for flexibility of scheduling faculty resources.

Rationale:

The Department sees MGMT 201 as a useful course for students from a wide variety of disciplines. All graduates will be required to work in some type of organization, in both leadership and non-leadership roles. This course provides the foundations for understanding basic human relations principles.
