1. Delete: On page 163, the prerequisite for HWP 316, Maternal and Infant Health:

Prerequisite: completion of the ILS Health and Wellness requirement; HWP 253.

Add: On page 163, in place of deleted entry:

Prerequisite: completion of the ILS Health and Wellness requirement.

Impact Statement: HWP 316 has been an elective course for the HWP major, but until the current semester had not been taught. It is currently being offered by one of our tenure-track faculty members. Removing the prerequisite makes it possible for students to use this course as an option to HWP 225, 253 and 365 to complete requirements for graduation.

Rationale: Adding an additional choice to the health promotion content section of the requirements to graduation will help students complete graduation requirements in a timely manner and will reduce pressure on HWP 253 and HWP 225 (two courses taught with over-enrolled sections each year). Maternal and infant health qualifies as important health promotion content.
