Statement of Faculty Senate Action

APC Document 93: Delete CSCI 242, 342 and 446

Effective Date: Fall 2013

1. Delete: On page 113, the entry for **CSCI 242:**

242 Programming Visual Applications (3)

Development of event-driven graphical applications using an integrated development environment. Prerequisite: CSCI 181 or 182 or permission of instructor.

Impact: None.

Rationale: Mobile and web interfaces are replacing windows-based personal computer interfaces. This course is being replaced by CSCI 344 as a requirement in the information system concentration.

2. Delete: On page 114, the entry for CSCI 342:

342 System Analysis and Design Methods (3)

Study of the concepts and techniques utilized in the analysis and design of an information system throughout the system development cycle. Prerequisites: CSCI 242, 343. Fall

Impact: None. This course has not been taught for several terms.

Rationale: Design methods are now taught throughout our curriculum. We do not need a specialized course in this topic.

3. Delete: On page 115, the entry for CSCI 446:

446 System Analysis and Design Project (3)

Experience in designing, developing, documenting, testing and implementing a significant project in a teamwork environment. Prerequisite: CSCI 342. Fall

Impact: None. This course has not been taught for several terms.

Rationale: Team projects are now incorporated into many of our upper-level courses. We do not believe it is necessary to offer a specialized course in this area any longer.
