Statement of Faculty Senate Action:

APC Document 41: Remove computer competency requirement from Biology, Classics, Computer Science, Drama, Economics, Environmental Studies, Health and Wellness, Interdisciplinary Studies, Management, Physics, Political Science, Psychology, Religious Studies, Sociology and Anthropology

Effective Date: Fall 2013

1. Biology

Delete: On page 91, under Requirements for All Biology Majors, in item III:

Major, oral and computer competencies are satisfied by completion of BIOL 480 or 498 with a grade of C or higher.

Add: On page 91, in place of deleted entry:

Major and oral competencies are satisfied by completion of BIOL 480 or 498 with a grade of C or higher.

2. Classics

Delete: On pages 105-106, the last sentence in item IV under all concentrations in Classics:

Computer competency will be demonstrated through successful completion of CLAS 495.

3. Computer Science

Delete: On page 112, in item III for both concentrations in Computer Science:

Major, oral and computer competencies are demonstrated by successful completion of CSCI 462.

Add: On page 112, in place of deleted entries:

Major and oral competencies are demonstrated by successful completion of CSCI 462.

4. Drama

Delete: On page 116, the last sentence in item III under Major in Drama:

Computer competency is demonstrated through successful completion of DRAM 122.

5. Economics

Delete: On page 121, the last sentence in item III under both Major in Economics and Economics with Teacher Licensure:

Demonstration of computer competency is met by completion of ECON 365.

6a. Environmental Studies

Delete: On page 140, the last sentence in item III in the listing of Environmental Studies requirements:

Completion of ENVR 241, 330 and 490 fulfills the all-university computer competency requirement.

6b. Environmental Studies

Delete: On page 141, the last sentence in item IV in the listing of Earth Science with 9-12 Licensure:

Completion of ENVR 241, 330, and either ENVR 490 or EDUC 455 fulfills the all-university computer competency requirement.

7a. Health and Wellness Promotion

Delete: On page 154, the first sentence in item III under Major in Health and Wellness Promotion:

Computer competency is demonstrated by completion of HWP 190 with a grade of C or better.

7b. Health and Wellness Promotion

Delete: On page 154, the sentence in item III under Major in Health and Wellness Promotion with Teacher Licensure:

Computer, oral and major competencies are demonstrated by completion of HWP 459 with a grade of C or better.

Add: On page 154, in place of deleted entry:

Major and oral competencies are demonstrated by completion of HWP 459 with a grade of C or better.

8a. Interdisciplinary Studies

Delete: On page 181, the first sentence in item IV under Requirements for Concentration in Ethics and Social Institutions:

Senior demonstration of major, oral and computer competency is met by successful completion of ESI 490 with a grade of C or higher.

Add: On page 181, in place of deleted entry:

Senior demonstration of major and oral competency is met by successful completion of ESI 490 with a grade of C or higher.

8b. Interdisciplinary Studies

Delete: On page 182, item 4 under Requirements for an Individual Degree Concentration:

The capstone experience should synthesize and summarize the major, and demonstrate major, oral and computer competency.

Add: On page 182, in place of deleted entry:

The capstone experience should synthesize and summarize the major, and demonstrate major and oral competency.

8c. Interdisciplinary Studies

Delete: On page 184, the first sentence in item III under Requirements for Concentration in International Studies:

Major and computer competency are demonstrated through successful completion of 3 hours from a course that produces original research on a topic related to international studies as approved by the INTS director.

Add: On page 184, in place of deleted entry:

Major competency is demonstrated through successful completion of 3 hours from a course that produces original research on a topic related to international studies as approved by the INTS director.

9. Management

Delete: On page 121, the last sentence in item III under General Requirements for Management:

A passing score on a standardized test after achieving junior standing demonstrates computer (business technology) competency.

10. Physics

Delete: On pages 246-247, the last sentence in item III under all concentrations in Physics:

Computer competency is demonstrated in PHYS 331 and 332 during oral presentations judged to be satisfactory by the departmental faculty.

11. Political Science

Delete: On page 250, the last sentence in item III under both Major in Political Science and Political Science with Teacher Licensure:

Computer and oral competency are satisfied by POLS 460.

Add: On page 250, in place of deleted entry:

Oral competency is satisfied by POLS 460.

12. Psychology

Delete: On page 257, the last sentence in item III under Major in Psychology:

Computer competency is demonstrated by successful completion of a designated project.

13a. Religious Studies

Delete: On page 262, the last sentence in item III under Major in Religious Studies:

Completion of RELS 490 with a grade of C or better demonstrates oral and computer competencies.

Add: On page 262, in place of deleted entry:

Completion of RELS 490 with a grade of C or better demonstrates oral competency.

13b. Religious Studies

Delete: On page 265, the course description for RELS 490:

Student research under the supervision of approved faculty resulting in the successful completion and oral presentation of a written thesis or comparable research project. This course fulfills the requirements for the oral and computer competencies. An IP grade may be awarded at the discretion of the instructor. Prerequisite: RELS 398. Fall.

Add: On page 265, in place of deleted entry:

Student research under the supervision of approved faculty resulting in the successful completion and oral presentation of a written thesis or comparable research project. This course fulfills the requirements for oral competency. An IP grade may be awarded at the discretion of the instructor. Prerequisite: RELS 398. Fall.

14a. Sociology and Anthropology

Delete: On page 266, the sentence in item III under both Major in Sociology and Sociology with Teacher Licensure:

Completing SOC 455 with a grade of C or better satisfies the senior demonstration of competency, oral competency, and computer competency requirements.

Add: On page 266, in place of deleted entry:

Completing SOC 455 with a grade of C or better satisfies the senior demonstration of competency and the oral competency requirements.

14b. Sociology and Anthropology

Delete: On page 267, the sentence in item III under both Major in Anthropology and Anthropology with Teacher Licensure:

Completing ANTH 455 with a grade of C or better satisfies the senior demonstration of competency, oral competency, and computer competency requirements.

Add: On page 267, in place of deleted entry:

Completing ANTH 455 with a grade of C or better satisfies the senior demonstration of competency and the oral competency requirements.
