Statement of Faculty Senate Action:

APC Document 55: Changing prerequisite for MGMT 386; Changing prerequisite for MGMT 484

**Effective Date: Fall 2013** 

1. Delete: On page 210, the prerequisite for MGMT 386, Management Information Systems:

Prerequisite: ACCT 216; MGMT 220.

**Add:** On page 210 in place of deleted entry:

Prerequisites: ACCT 216 or 317; MGMT 220.

Impact: None

**Rationale:** ACCT 216 (Principles of Accounting II) is currently required as a prerequisite for MGMT 386. ACCT 216 is required by management majors, but not accounting majors. Accounting majors take a more detailed version of the material in ACCT 317 (Cost Accounting). Accounting students who wish to change their major to Management are currently required to get permission to take MGMT 386. This prerequisite change would make the formality of getting that permission unnecessary for those students who have passed ACCT 317.

**2. Delete:** On page 211, the prerequisite for **MGMT 484, Senior Seminar:** 

Prerequisites: ACCT 216, senior standing, and at least 6 hours of 300-level management

courses.

**Add:** On page 211, in place of the deleted entry:

Prerequisites: ACCT 216 or 317, senior standing, and at least 6 hours of 300-level

management courses.

Impact: None.

**Rationale:** ACCT 216 (Principles of Accounting II) is currently required as a prerequisite for MGMT 484. ACCT 216 is required by management majors, but not accounting majors. Instead, accounting majors take a more detailed version of the material in ACCT 317 (Cost Accounting). If an accounting major wishes to take MGMT 484, special permission must be given. This prerequisite change will allow accounting students access to the course as an elective without the need for special permission.
