1. Delete: On page 118, the description of DRAM 105, Theatre Practicum:

8514S

Intensive laboratory experience in one area of theatre production. Subject arranged individually. May be repeated for a total of 4 hours of credit. Permission of instructor is required. Grading S/U. Fall and Spring.

Add: On page 118, in place of deleted entry:

Intensive laboratory experience in one area of theatre production. Subject arranged individually. May be repeated for a total of 4 hours credit. May not be taken by Drama majors and minors. Permission of instructor is required. Grading is S/U. Fall and Spring.

2. Delete: On page 118, the entry for **DRAM 106**:

106 Theatre Production (1)

Intensive laboratory experience in production and performance work for Theatre UNCA. Open only to Drama majors or minors. May be repeated for a total of 6 hours of credit. Permission of instructor is required. Fall and Spring.

Impact: None. DRAM 105 will now be for non-majors and minors, and DRAM 106 is no longer needed.

Rationale: With the addition of DRAM 201, 202, 203 and 204, Drama majors and minors will take these courses to meet graduation requirements, and should not take DRAM 105. Any majors who would like to have production credit beyond 201-204 can propose to receive credit as a Special Topics or Undergraduate Research course. This will also ensure that those students are expected to apply higher level skills, critical thinking, and artistry.
