# Appendix I: Projected Teaching Schedule for History Department - 2015 to 2020

**Executive summary:** This report addresses concerns expressed by APC related to delivery of the curriculum, support for LAC and interdisciplinary studies, and compliance with GA standards on teaching load based on Organized Course Sections for our proposed move to 4 hour courses.

**Assumptions:** The following projection assumes current staffing levels and the ongoing volunteer classes delivered by Bill Spellman.

**Delivery of the Curriculum:** As you will note in the following Projected Teaching Schedules the History Department projects that the full curriculum will be delivered every two years. We will offer our courses required of every major--two sections of 210, 220, 451, and 452 and one section of 250--every semester. 300-level electives will be offered at least every two years and we will offer at least two 300-level European, U.S., and World History courses every semester.

**Support of LAC:** The department will continue to fully support the LAC program in a manner consistent with our tradition of providing a high level of support. We project offering two sections of HIST 178 every fall for the next five years. We will teach at least 8 sections of HUM every semester and in most fall semesters will teach 9. Numbers of HUM courses taught each semester are listed at the bottom of each semester's schedule.

**Support of Interdisciplinarity:** We will continue our support of university interdisciplinary programs and other Humanities majors such as WGSS, Africana Studies, Religious Studies, and International Studies. We will teach 4 to 8 such courses per semester. Numbers of Interdisciplinary courses taught each semester are listed at the bottom of each semester's schedule.

Meeting GA Standards on Organized Course Sections: Given a department of 9 tenure-track faculty, with one course release time per semester for the chair, GA expects us to teach (as best I can figure) 34 Organized Course Sections (as described by the Delaware Study) per semester. We project that we will exceed that number every semester for the next five years at current staffing levels. The number of Organized Course Sections taught each semester is listed at the bottom of each semester's schedule.
