

Appendix II: Degree Completion Plan for Transfer Students with 44-Hour Core and 60 Hours of Coursework

Assumptions: Since we cannot address every transfer situation, the following schedule assumes the most common scenario, transfer of the 44-hour core and 60 total hours of coursework.

Unusual situation for History transfers: Most such students receive HUM 124 and 214 credit for the World Civilization classes they took at their previous school. In the past, this meant that they received course credit for HIST 251 and 252 but 0 credit hours. To make up the six hours, such students were required to take two additional 300-level courses to make up for the hours. This has been the policy for much longer than my 9-year tenure as chair.

With our new curriculum, students will only be required to take one additional 4-hour 300-level course (as opposed to two 3-hour course in the past).
