1. Delete: On page 182, the description for INTS 354:

# **354** The Nuclear Dilemma (3)

Students explore the technological, economic, social, political, and legal challenges posed by the proliferation of nuclear technology and weapons over the last fifty years, and examine the historical and contemporary efforts of the international community to address these challenges. Spring.

Add: On page 182, in place of deleted entry:

#### **354** The Nuclear Dilemma (3)

This course examines the challenges associated with nuclear power, weapons, terrorism and international security issues connected to nuclear weapons. International renewable energy development as an alternative to nuclear power and its associated potential for nuclear weapons proliferation is also examined. Spring.

**Impact:** The new description more accurately describes the course and will be clearer to potential students. The course has been offered every semester for several years. There are no resource implications with this change.

**Rationale:** Allowing students to have a clearer picture of the course may encourage more students to take it. The course helps inform students who may act as citizens in ways that will make the planet more sustainable.
