Statement of Faculty Senate Action:

**APC Document 62 (MUSC):**

**Reinstate MUSC 207, Conducting**

**Effective Date:** Fall 2016

**1. Add:** On page 232, **MUSC 207, Conducting:**

**207 Conducting (2)**

Emphasizes basic through refined conducting skills for both choral and orchestral conducting. Prerequisite: MUSC 232 or permission of instructor. See department chair.

**Impact Statement:** There will be no impact on the resources and staffing of the Music department due to this change. No new equipment or space will be required.

**Rationale:** This course was sunsetted in 2011 due to a departmental focus away from musicology and music pedagogy as part of the discontinuation of the BA in Music. Since then the music department has restructured its degree program offerings and added a new BFA in Jazz and Contemporary Music. Conducting is a skill every musician needs to master and should be included in both the BFA and the BA training. Though it is not yet a requirement, a majority of music students will be encouraged to add this to their chosen elective courses.
