Statement of Faculty Senate Action:

FWDC 11: Reduction in the Required Number of Nominees

for the Academic Board of Appeals Election

Faculty Handbook Section 10.2.7

Summary: This document reduces the number of required nominees from 7 to 4.

Rationale: Currently we must find 7 nominees to fill 2 new positions each year. It typically requires repeated requests to gather enough faculty members willing to serve.

Effective Date: The 2017 - 2018 Academic Year

Make the following Changes to 10.2.7 Academic Appeals Board

<u>Membership</u>

- Four faculty members, two elected annually at large by the faculty from a list of no fewer than seven four nominees provided by the Faculty Senate,
- Three students plus one alternate elected by the Student Government Association (SGA)
- Faculty Conciliator.

The four faculty elected to AAB by the faculty shall serve a two year staggered term; they may be elected to serve a second term; they may not be elected to a third term until they have been off the Board for at least two years. An effort should be made to provide for representation from the three program areas. Alternates shall serve a one year term and a new alternate elected each year. Student members of the AAB and the Faculty Conciliator shall each serve a term of one year. The Faculty Conciliator may not serve more than three consecutive terms.
