Statement of Faculty Senate Action:

APC Document 28 (ART): Change ART 133 from a prerequisite to a pre- or corequisite for ART 204, 218, 254 and 264

Impact Statement: This proposed change does not affect major, minor, and/or university requirements including the number of hours needed to graduate. This proposal does not affect staffing and/or course offerings. There is no anticipation of change in enrollment in ART 133 as a direct reflection from this change.

Rationale: This proposed change will allow students to begin introductory course work sooner within their chosen 2-D area of concentration--Drawing, Painting, Photography, Printmaking--by allowing them to take the required 3-dimensional foundation design course (ART 133) concurrently with a first level studio course. Students will still be required to complete the 2-D foundation course (ART 122) prior to beginning the first level 3-dimensional studio course.
