Statement of Faculty Senate Action:

**APC Document 44 (CLAS):**

**Change to AP Latin Credit**

**Effective date: Fall 2018**

**1. Delete:** On page 36, the Latin entry for Advanced Placement:

	4, 5	3	CLAS 212
Virgil	3	4	CLAS 102
	4, 5	3	CLAS 212

**Add:** On page 36, in place of deleted entry:

Latin	3	4	CLAS 101
	4, 5	4	CLAS 102

**Impact:** This change will not have a negative impact on our curriculum or staffing, but will require incoming students to score a 4-5 in order to receive credit for the LAC second language requirement. IB scores will remain unchanged.

**Rationale:** AP Latin now only offers one exam (Caesar and Virgil combined), so this change reflects the current AP Latin Placement Exam that is available to high school students. Since the current exam is less comprehensive than the previous ones, we have adjusted the amount of credit we offer for it. We also no longer offer CLAS 212 every semester.
