Statement of Faculty Senate Action:

APC Document 62 (NM): **Change when NM 330 and 344 are offered**

Effective Date: Fall 2018

1. **Replace:** On page 252, the “**current**” entries describing course offering patterns, as listed in the tables below, with the “**proposed**” offerings listed:

Courses in NM	Current	Proposed
330 Internet Art	Spring	See department chair
344 History of Design	Fall	See department chair

Impact: There will be no impact on the resources and staffing of the NM department due to this change. No new lab equipment or space will be needed. Both of these courses are options to fulfill NM major requirements, but because the other courses that fulfill the requirements are offered on a regular basis, we anticipate little impact.

Rationale: Internet Art is taught in the spring when it is taught, but it is not offered every spring. Likewise, History of Design is taught in the fall when it is taught, but it is not offered every fall. These changes more accurately communicate to the students that the courses aren’t offered every fall or spring.
