Statement of Faculty Senate Action:

APC Document 14 (SOC/ANTH): Delete ANTH 355, Marginality and Radicalization

Effective Date: Fall 2021

1. Delete: On page 292, in course listings for Anthropology, **ANTH 355:**

355 Marginality and Radicalization (4)

Explores contemporary forms of marginality and radicalism, as well as the quests for meaning and belonging that accompany them. Course draws on anthropological, sociological and philosophical texts. Junior standing and/or background in socio-cultural theory is strongly recommended. See department chair.

Impact: This deletion will have no impact on the curriculum in the department or any university programs. The course served as an elective for Soc and Anth majors and minors. With the addition of a new course, there is an equal number of Anthropology electives available for students to complete their major and minor requirements. This course was not affiliated with or required by other programs.

Rationale: The faculty who was singularly qualified to teach this course is no longer in the department. This was a specialty area that has been replaced by other specialty areas of the faculty who now fills the position in the department.
