Notes and Rationale for the Revised Academic Calendars 2016-17 and 2017-18

- 1. When, in spring semesters, the first day of classes is after the Martin Luther King Holiday, the university is committed to continue and to expand all of events associated with the Martin Luther King Holiday, including the Day of Service.
- 2. Each of the four semesters of the revised calendar has 70 class days and 5 days of exams, fulfilling the GA requirement of 75 instructional days.
- 3. Each of the four semesters <u>begins one week later</u> than the current adopted calendars (with the exception of Fall 2017). <u>Both fall semesters have a week of classes following the Thanksgiving holiday.</u>
- 4. The fall breaks, Monday and Tuesday in October, are one week later because of the later start. The spring breaks, a full week in March, have been moved one week later again due to later start of semester.
- 5. In the revised calendars, fall semesters have 14 Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays for regular classes. The spring semesters in revised calendars have 14 Mondays, 15 Tuesdays, 13 Wednesdays, 14 Thursdays, and 14 Fridays for regular classes.
- 6. Undergraduate Research will schedule its spring symposium on Wednesday of the fourth week of April rather than Wednesday of third week in April, which provides additional time for students to prepare for their presentations.
- 7. The Calendar Advisory Group was convened by the Provost and consists of the following: Joe Urgo, Pat McClellan, Gwen Ashburn (Academic Affairs), Jackie McHargue, Nancy Yeager (Student Affairs), and Terri Brne (Athletics).
- 8. The later start in January opens the possibility for special class trips and/or short classes on campus. It also provides additional time for staff to prepare for new students and other activities associated with the start of the semester.
