Statement of Faculty Senate Action:

**APC Document 26 (HIST):** **Delete the following courses in the History curriculum:  
HIST 309, 310, 338, 347, 348, 350, and 358**

**Effective Date: Fall 2019**

**1. Delete:** On pages 167-170, the following courses:

HIST 309 History of the “Old South”  
HIST 310 African American History to 1865  
HIST 338 History of Brazil  
HIST 347 History of Ireland  
HIST 348 Britain to 1688  
HIST 350 Britain Since 1688  
HIST 358 European Feminisms

**Impact:** None anticipated. Although HIST 309, 310, 350, and 358 are used by other majors and minors (Africana Studies, U.S. Ethnic Studies, International Studies, and Women, Gender and Sexuality Studies), these programs have many other courses from which students can choose. The chairs/directors of these programs have been notified of the deletions.

**Rationale:** HIST 358 is no longer a part of Dr. Rizzo’s rotation, and there is no plan to teach it in the future. With Dr. Waters’ move to administration and Dr. Spellman’s retirement, we no longer have the personnel to offer the remaining courses.
