**Impact Statement:** We do not believe that these course deletions should have any negative impact on the Political Science major or minor, or on university requirements. In terms of the department, since no Political Science faculty currently have expertise in these areas, these changes more accurately reflect our abilities and allow us to offer other courses that better meet faculty and student interests. Further, none of these courses are required for the Political Science major or minor. Instead, these are simply courses that the department has been unable to offer in recent years. Their deletion will provide students with more accurate information on the current topics that can be covered by the department. None of these courses was required for the Liberal Arts Core, either. A couple of these courses were offered as electives in programs outside the department, but they have not been offered in many years. For this reason, we do not believe that deleting them from the catalog will have any additional negative impact outside the department.
