Statement of Faculty Senate Action:

**APC Document 33 (ACCT): Editorial changes needed due to changing ACCT 215 to 4 credits**

**Effective Date: Fall 2022**

**1. Delete:** On page 38, under **Cambridge Advanced International Certificate Exams:**

**Add:** On page 38, in place of deleted entry:

<b>Accounting</b>	AS	C	4	ACCT 215
	A	C	8	ACCT 215, 216

**2. Delete:** On page 186, item I under **Requirements for Concentration in Arts Management and Entrepreneurship:**

I. Required courses for the major—at least 31 hours: ACCT 215; ARTS 310; ECON 306; IST 310; LANG 354 or NM 231; MGMT 130, 250, 300, 366.

**Add:** On page 186, in place of deleted entry:

I. Required courses for the major—at least 32 hours: ACCT 215; ARTS 310; ECON 306; IST 310; LANG 354 or NM 231; MGMT 130, 250, 300, 366.

**3. Delete:** On page 186, under **Minor in Arts Management and Entrepreneurship:**

Required courses for the minor—at least 23 hours: ACCT 215; ARTS 310; IST 310; MGMT 130, 250 and 366; and at least 4 credit hours from the courses listed below.

**Add:** On page 186, in place of deleted entry:

Required courses for the minor—at least 24 hours: ACCT 215; ARTS 310; IST 310; MGMT 130, 250 and 366; and at least 4 credit hours from the courses listed below.

4. **Delete:** On page 219, item I under **Major in Management:**
- I. Required core major courses—36 hours: MGMT 130, 230, 250, 300, 380, 386, 398, 480; ACCT 215, 216.

**Add:** On page 219, in place of deleted entry:

- I. Required core major courses—38 hours: MGMT 130, 230, 250, 300, 380, 386, 398, 480; ACCT 215, 216.

5. **Delete:** On page 220, under **Minor in Management:**  
At least 19 hours, including: ACCT 215; MGMT 130, 230, 300 and 6 additional hours of MGMT courses at the 300-level or above.

**Add:** On page 220, in place of deleted entry:

At least 20 hours, including: ACCT 215; MGMT 130, 230, 300 and 6 additional hours of MGMT courses at the 300-level or above.

6. **Unchanged:** On page 238, item II under **Concentration in Statistics:**

- II. Required courses outside the major—9-11 hours, including: CSCI 182 or 183, and either ACCT 215 and ECON 306; or ECON 103 and 305; or MGMT 130 and 380; or 6 hours at the 300-400 level approved by the department chair from disciplines which routinely employ statistical methodology. Students interested in actuarial science are strongly encouraged to take ACCT 215, ECON 103, 305, and 306.

**Impact:** The change in ACCT 215 from three credit hours to four credit hours will impact the degree programs that include ACCT 215 as either a required course or in a list of courses students may select from to complete the degree program.

In Management, ACCT 215 and ACCT 216 are listed as requirements for the Management major, and ACCT 215 is required for the minor in Management. The proposed increase in credit hours for ACCT 215 and ACCT 216 will add two credit hours to the major and one credit hour to the minor. Currently enrolled students who have yet to declare Management as a major or minor will be advised to declare prior to Fall 2022. Professor Ghidina has concurred with this proposed increase in the credit hours for ACCT 215 and ACCT 216.

In Interdisciplinary Studies, the Concentration in Arts Management and Entrepreneurship (AME) and the AME minor require ACCT 215. The proposed increase in credit hours for ACCT 215 will add one credit hour to these programs. Professor Galloway has concurred with this proposed increase in the credit hours for ACCT 215.

In Mathematics, the Concentration in Statistics lists ACCT 215 with other courses as part of 9-11 hours outside the major. The proposed increase in credit hours for ACCT 215 does not change the overall range of 9-11 hours, but does make the option of ACCT 215 and ECON 306 hit the upper limit of 11 hours. Professor Kaplan has concurred with this proposed increase in the credit hours for ACCT 215.

**Rationale:** These are needed editorial changes to reflect the increase in hours for ACCT 215 and 216.
